On the way home we will be staying with missionaries in Kenya, who really need our encouragement after a year of post-election strife. We will be visiting Dandora - the slums of Nairobi where we were able to teach last year. Our hearts yearn for better circumstances for those living in such poverty!

We are praising God for those who have donated supplies for the team to take to relieve some of the distress we will encounter.

That was the experience on the recent mission trip to Guyana. The Lord provided Burnell & Wavney Fields of Albany, New York to share in the Easter conferences at Camp Street, Georgetown, New Amsterdam, Lethem and in the Pomeroun.

It was interesting to see how we were challenged to respond to a situation that required our flexibility such as one in the Pomeroun where there was to be a baptism the very Sunday morning that we arrived. The pastor had sent a message postponing the baptism to the following week - which never got to the church. As a result, 10 people came expecting to be baptised. How can you disappoint people on such a special occasion? The pastor didn't have a change of clothing and neither did any of us, so I simply made myself available to do the baptism in my full garb and let Bro. Fields do the ministry. Needless to say how happy the candidates were! It was a blessed day meeting around the Lord's table, in ministry and doing health education with men and women separately.

We were privileged to help the Gideons in Georgetown establish a Gideon Camp in the Rupununi. Now the children will have access to scriptures which will be distributed in the schools. The camp will be launched later in the year.

Last year as we were leaving Yupukari we gave a small chainsaw to the church leaders to help them with the building of their church - only to return this year to see that they are already worshipping in the new church. Praise the Lord! **"Little is much when God is in it."**

A set of Books on CD's with over 2,000 volumes was presented to the Principal of Open Bible Standard Churches Education Centre in San Fernando, Trinidad; a value of over \$750,000.

We praise God for the opportunity to partner with the Gideons, who are now storing Bibles in our warehouse at Esna Park.
