BOOKS: URGENT NEED

As the deer pants for the water brooks, so do the souls of many students in Bible Schools and Seminaries for the books waiting to be shipped! Over the years MATE/FCC has had the opportunity of serving over 140 institutions in 41 countries with books and other study materials. Last year we shipped over 20,000 volumes to 4 countries. Sitting in the warehouse are 5 shipments of 30,000 volumes for Zambia, Kenya, India, Jamaica and Trinidad waiting the necessary funds to be shipped to their destinations.



Cost to ship in U.S. dollars: Zambia - \$8,000; Kenya - \$6,000; India - \$7,000; Jamaica - \$4,000; Trinidad - \$5,000.

Will you consider making a financial contribution toward the shipments of these books so they could get into the hands of men and women who are hungry for that which will enrich their lives and ministry? The cost of shipping one box is approximately \$40.00.

The membership of MATE/FCC met **Saturday April 22** for its annual meeting. The ministry was reviewed, and elections were held for the Board of Directors.

WATER FOR LIFE PROJECT REPORT

WE HAVE PASSED THE HALFWAY MARK! So far we have received over \$35,000.00 towards our \$60,000.00 goal.

GUYANA MISSION REPORT

Keswick: Guyana held its first Keswick Convention March 26th-31st. Many committed themselves to the Lord and to ministry.

The MATE/FCC team returned to Toronto on April 15th tired but extremely grateful to God for what He accomplished over the 3-week stay.



Medical Teaching: Lectures were given in Georgetown at the University, the nursing school and to the medical association. Groups of waiting patients received instruction in managing chronic health concerns, prevention of back injury, and exercise.

In New Amsterdam, our doctors were able to lecture to healthcare personnel, as well as participate in a TV talk show on health issues.

Cathy Marshall, a sonographer, trained technicians to use ultrasound equipment at New Amsterdam Hospital.

Clinics: 1200 patients seen. The team Dentist averaged 16 extractions per day at nine separate medical centres.

Computers: Mathew Abraham taught computer technology for 2 weeks in Mahaicony to a class graduating 42 students.

Youth: A day of sporting activities for the youth was climaxed by a youth rally and the gift of sporting gear from MATE/FCC. Thanks to the youth group from Georgetown who travelled to Mahaicony to encourage the youth with their fellowship!

Team Member Testimony: *"The Lord opened my eyes to see the needs that exist around the world. We had to adjust to different modes of travel, to the availability - or not - of water for drinking and bathing. N.B. team members need to be adaptable!
